



The **North Carolina Cottey College Scholarship Fund (NCCCSF)** is established for the purpose of helping female residents of North Carolina pursue their education at Cottey College. The Fund is maintained entirely by voluntary donation gifts from individuals, chapters, and by bequests. A One-Time Named NC Cottey College Scholarship is another way chapters or individuals can support the **NCCCSF** mission of educating NC women by attending Cottey College.

Requirements for Application

- Be recommended by a local P.E.O. Chapter
- Be a North Carolina resident
- Have been accepted for admission by Cottey College
- Complete the renewal application, if a returning student to Cottey College

The selection criteria includes integrity of character, scholastic ability, school and community activities. The scholarship is renewable upon maintenance of a 2.5 grade point average each year.

Information for Chapters

Encourage young women from North Carolina to explore attending Cottey College in Nevada, Missouri. If you know of a young woman who is interested, support her in applying for the NC Cottey College Scholarship. Here are the steps:

- Obtain scholarship application and instructions from the current chair of the North Carolina Cottey College Scholarship Fund (NCCCSF) Board of Trustees (BOT) or from the NC. P.E.O. website: <https://members.peonc.org/projects/ncccsf/>
- Meet with the student in person/virtually or via phone and assist her in completing the application, if needed. Your chapter will need to write and submit a letter of recommendation to the NCCCSF BOT as part of the application process.
- Follow up to ensure the scholarship application is submitted in a timely manner.

Information for One-Time Named Scholarships

A named NC Cottey College Scholarship is a one-time scholarship presented to a woman who meets the NCCCSF eligibility requirements as established for the fund. This scholarship amount is commensurate with the then current base amount for an International Foundation Fund. Funds for this one-time scholarship shall be made up of donations from individuals, chapters or collective gifts and may be named in honor or memory of an individual or chapter.

- This requires a total donation of the base amount for an International Foundation Fund given in one fiscal giving year for P.E.O. (March 1 – January 31)
- Funds to be designated for a named scholarship must be received by the NC Assistant Treasurer no later than January 31 for the ensuing academic year. A donation form can be found at <https://members.peonc.org/projects/> or by contacting Diane Vezmar at ncpeoasstreas@gmail.com .
- Each named NCCCSF scholarship recipient shall be selected by the NCCCSF BOT using the same criteria as for the selection of other NCCCSF recipients.
- Recipient(s) receiving named scholarship(s) shall be advised of this special designation prior to the formal announcement of NC Cottey College Scholarships made during the annual NC State Chapter convention. The recipient(s) may be invited to attend the activity at the NC State Chapter Convention when the announcement is made. A recognition certificate shall reflect this named scholarship designation.
- A one-time named scholarship provides special recognition in honor or memory and is not in addition to a NCCCSF regular scholarship.
